

Syllabus of Paediatric Propedeutic

The purpose of the teaching course is to become acquainted with the basics of paediatric propaedeutics, physiologic aspects of the growth and child development, changes in clinical examination in various stages of growth, and to familiarize oneself with the basics of preventive care in children from the newborn period until adolescence. The teaching includes a theoretical and practical part at the child's bedside, but it is mainly focused on teaching on simulators. This will take place in cooperation with the Center for Medical Simulations of the Institute of Physiology of the 1st Faculty of Medicine of the Charles University.

In clinical setting we will focus on taking the patients history and on basic physical examinations.

Students will be divided to 4 groups A-D, each of 10 students

Teaching requirements: medical gown, slippers, students ID card, stethoscope, FFP2 mask

Expected is full attendance for credit
